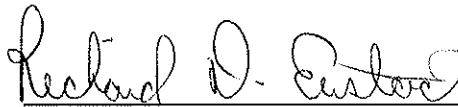

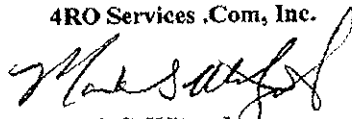

Rich for the work at 293 Cherry Lane to replace either 10 feet of the sewer main in the roadway or the 71 feet from manhole to manhole see below the costs.

Eagle is only supplying Labor and equipment to excavate, remove and install new piping (pipe & fittings supplied by BSA), labor and equipment to install owners quarry blend materials, labor and equipment to remove soils to your yard on our truck, labor and equipment to Saw cut asphalt, and labor, material and equipment to complete the asphalt patching of roadway with 4" base and 2" top. Asphalt Patching to be done immediately following backfill. Asphalt patching is not curb to curb but a 6" overcut of our trench only.
