**RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY,
IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY
AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF A PERFORMANCE BOND FOR
QUICKCHEK CORPORATION**

WHEREAS, QuickChek Corporation (“QuickChek”) has requested a full refund of the performance bond it previously placed in connection with the work it performed in for the QuickCheck of Bordentown; and

WHEREAS, the Bordentown Sewerage Authority’s Consulting Engineer has reported that the work has been completed in an acceptable manner however several administrative obligations remain open;

WHEREAS, the Authority’s Consulting Engineer has recommended the full release of the performance guarantee in the amount of \$34,800.00 provided all administrative obligations are completed to the satisfaction of the Engineer and payment of outstanding fees have been resolved and the conditions set forth below are satisfied; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Board of the Bordentown Sewerage Authority this 17th day of July, 2017, that:

1. The aforementioned performance bond numbered as CMS0283258 in the amount of \$34,800.00 is hereby released subject to QuickChek satisfying the Authorities Engineer’s open items set forth on Exhibit “A” attached hereto.

2. A maintenance bond in the amount of \$3,480.00 shall be required to be posted by QuickChek Corporation as a condition of this release.
3. Any and all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Dear Mr. Eustace:

The Applicant has requested a release of the performance bond associated with the wastewater facilities provided at the site. In general, the site contains a grease trap with a lateral connection and a separate lateral for restroom/sink areas. The amount of the bond is \$34,800.00

At this time we recommend release of the performance bond pending the following:

- The providing of an acceptable post construction video of the existing sewer main showing no irregularities near the project lateral connections.
- The filing of an acceptable access easement across the property for Authority access to an adjacent pump station has been satisfied.
- Signed PDF copy and 3 paper copies of the site as-built shall be provided. Based on the video the distances from upstream manhole to lateral; lateral to lateral and lateral to downstream manhole shall be indicated. Since there are no manhole inverts associated with this work the signing of the as-built by a NJPE as opposed to a NJLS is acceptable.
