RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING A DEFERRED CONNECTION FEE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE AUTHORITY AND DCT MIDLINE, LLC.

WHEREAS, DCT MIDLINE, LLC (the "Developer"), is interested in securing sanitary sewer service for an industrial project proposed to be constructed on Rising Sun Road in Bordentown Township also known as Block 137.02, Lot 5.01 on the official tax map of the Township of Bordentown (the "Property") located at the intersection of Route I-295 and Rising Sun Road;

WHEREAS, the Authority's Executive Director after consultation with the Authority's consulting engineer and the Authority's solicitor believes that it is in the best of the rate payers of the Authority for the Developer to pay all related costs and fees associated with the extension of any sanitary sewer service that will further the development of the Property;

WHEREAS, the Developer has requested that it be permitted to pay the connection fee associated with the project over a limited period of time; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is willing to entertain an installment payment agreement with the Developer provided certain conditions are satisfied.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED, by the Board Members of the Bordentown

Sewerage Authority, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

1. A Deferred Connection Fee Agreement between The Bordentown Sewerage

Authority and DCT Midline, LLC, is hereby approved by the Authority.

2. The Authority's Executive Director and Administrative Manager are hereby

authorized to undertake any and all necessary actions to distribute the Agreement in

draft form to the Developer and their designated representatives for the purpose of the

Developer's execution of the same.

3. The Authority's Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on

behalf of the Authority.

4. Any and all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the

extent of such inconsistencies.
