RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF A PERFORMANCE BOND FOR APCO PETROLEUM, INC.

WHEREAS, APCO Petroleum, Inc. ("APCO") has completed the sewer connection of a gas station and 7-11 convenience store having an address of 247 Route 130, known as Block 121 Lot 3 on the Bordentown Township Tax Map; and

WHEREAS, the Bordentown Sewerage Authority's Consulting Engineer has reported that the APCO work has been completed in an acceptable manner;

WHEREAS, the Authority's Consulting Engineer has recommended the full release of the performance guarantee in the amount of \$16,800.00 provided all payments of outstanding fees have been resolved and the conditions set forth below are satisfied; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Board of the Bordentown Sewerage Authority this 20th day of May, 2019, that:

- 1. The aforementioned performance bond numbered as RU100680 in the amount of \$16,800.00 is hereby released.
- The on-site sanitary sewer extensions shall not be accepted for ownership or maintenance by The Bordentown Sewerage Authority, but instead, shall continue to be owned and maintained by the developer, its successors and assigns.

- 3. Since the on-site sanitary sewer extensions shall be owned and maintained by the developer, no maintenance guarantee shall be required.
- 4. Any and all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
