RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY CONSENTING TO THE PROPOSED TRICOUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT (WQM) PLAN AMENDMENT FOR RISING SUN MEADOWS, LLC

WHEREAS, Rising Sun Meadows, LLC (the "Developer") is intending to develop land identified on the official tax map of Bordentown Township as a portion of Block 138.01, Lots 41, 42, and 43 (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the NJDEP has established the WQM plan amendment procedure through the WQMP rules at N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5 as the method of incorporating unplanned facilities into a WQM plan; and

WHEREAS, a proposed WQM plan amendment publicly noticed in the New Jersey Register on April 20, 2020 for Rising Sun Meadows has been prepared by Bruce S. Friedman, Director, Division of Water Monitoring and Standards;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, THAT:

- 1. The Bordentown Sewerage Authority hereby consents to the Rising Sun Meadows amendment, and publicly noticed on April 20, 2020, prepared by Bruce S. Friedman, Director, Division of Water Monitoring and Standards, for the purpose of its incorporation into the applicable WQM plan(s).
- 2. This consent shall be submitted to the NJDEP pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(g)6.
