

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-57**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE  
AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW  
JERSEY REJECTING ALL BIDS AND AUTHORIZING  
REBID FOR THE MILE HOLLOW PUMP STATION  
PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, on May 18, 2020 the Bordentown Sewerage Authority (the "Authority") awarded a contract to Remington & Vernick Engineers to provide engineering design, advertisement/bid and contract endorsement phase services in connection with the addition of a third submersible raw sewage pump at the Mile Hollow Pump Station; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were received on July 21, 2020, both of which exceeded the Authority's budget for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2 states that a contracting unit may reject all bids when the lowest bid substantially exceeds the contracting unit's appropriation for goods and services; and;

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Authority to reject all bids received on July 21, 2020 for exceeding the amount budgeted for this project and authorize the revision of the specifications for rebid.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, this 27th day of July, 2020 that:

1. It hereby rejects all bids received for the Mile Hollow Pump Station Project for the reasons set forth in this resolution.
2. It hereby authorizes the revision of the specifications for the Mile Hollow Pump Station project to the extent feasible, and authorizes Remington & Vernick Engineers to determine the time, date and place for the receipt of bids, and to re-advertise.
