

**RESOLUTION 2020-102
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
CONSUMPTION REPORT AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, The Bordentown Sewerage Authority (Authority) is entrusted with the responsibility to acquire, construct, maintain, operate and improve works for the collection, treatment, purification or disposal of sewage wastes within the City of Bordentown and the Township of Bordentown, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:14A-1 et. seq., and

WHEREAS, the City of Bordentown, through its water department, provides potable water services to customers within the district served by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:14A-26(d) provides that each municipality operating a system of water distribution shall, from time to time after request therefore by the Authority, deliver to the Authority copies of the records made by it in the regular course of business of the amount of water supplied by it to every parcel of real property within the district and that the reasonable costs of preparation and delivering of such copies shall be paid by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has requested that such records be made available to it in order that the Authority may compute its consumption charges for sewerage services; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Consumption Report Agreement of January 1, 2021 and expiring on December 31, 2023 are satisfactory to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, a Certificate of Availability of Funds has been provided by the designated certifying officer and is attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 21st day of December, 2020, by The Bordentown Sewerage Authority that the Consumption Report Agreement by and between The Bordentown Sewerage Authority and the City of Bordentown be and the same is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary be and the same are hereby authorized and directed to execute the aforesaid Agreement on behalf of the Authority.

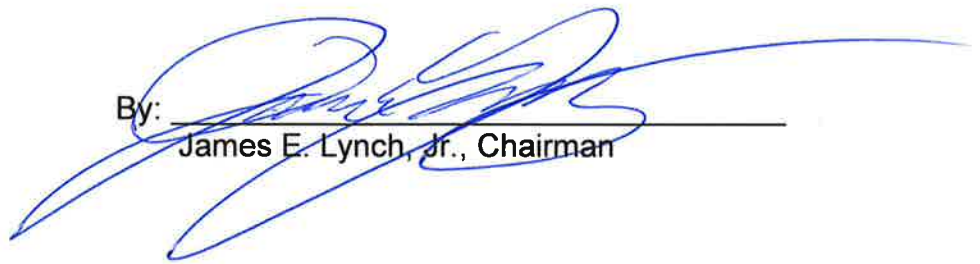

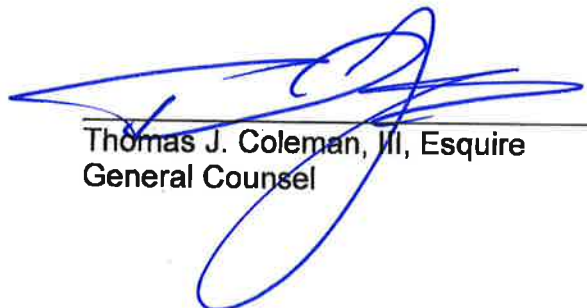

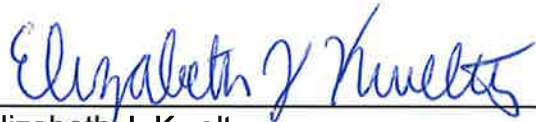
