**RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE
AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE
OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING HOURLY PAY
INCREASES FOR JAMES SULLIVAN AND QUENTIN
NIXON.**

WHEREAS, The Bordentown Sewerage Authority employs James Sullivan and Quentin Nixon both Sewer Maintenance Workers; and

WHEREAS, the Authority entered into a Collective Bargaining Agreement with Utility Workers of America, AFL-CIO and its Local 601, effective December 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Sewer Maintenance Workers are Union members covered by the Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement states "As of the effective date of this contract, all employees earning below \$20.00 per hour shall be increased to \$20.00 per hour";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED, by the Board Members of the Bordentown Sewerage Authority, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

1. Effective December 1, 2021, James Sullivan and Quentin Nixon will now earn an annual salary of \$41,600.00 together with any and all other benefits offered to Authority employees.
2. The Authority's Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute any forms or paperwork that may be needed.

3. Any and all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
