RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE RENEWAL & REPLACEMENT ACCOUNT TO FUND NECESSARY PLANT IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Bordentown Sewerage Authority (the "Authority") previously established a Renewal & Replacement Account for the purpose of funding improvements or replacements to the Authority's existing equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Authority authorized contract award with Resolution 2022-35 to Remington and Vernick engineers for the design, advertisement, and bidding services in the amount of \$22,400.00; and

WHEREAS, the Authority advertised for public bids and awarded a contract for wet well modifications to the Authority's Rising Sun Road pump station Sub-Level Installations, Inc. in the amount of \$233,880.00; and

WHEREAS, the Authority authorized contract award with Resolution 2022-51 to Remington and Vernick engineers for construction administration services in the amount of \$29,800.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board Members of the Bordentown Sewerage Authority, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

 A transfer in the amount of \$286,080.00 from the Renewal & Replacement Account held by the Trustee to the Operating Money Market Account held by Investors Bank shall take place.

- 2. The Authority's Executive Director and Administrative Manager are hereby authorized to undertake any and all necessary actions to ensure that this transfer is achieved in accordance with the directive of this Resolution.
- 3. Any and all Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
