

The following requisition is hereby being filed with you for the performance of emergency work or labor, or the furnishing of emergency materials, supplies and services,

The nature of the emergency is: Manhole overflowing raw sewage near 624 Rt 206 south, flowing into storm drain. Made several attempts to clear blockage, can only get upstream 50 feet before jet hose stops and brings back muddy water.

5/30/2023: Cause of blockage was PSEG utility pole through gravity sewer main.

The date and time of the emergency: 5/27/2023, 4 pm

The need for the emergency work or labor or the furnishing of emergency materials, supplies or services is as follows: Equipment and labor to excavate to sewer main, replace damaged 8" transite pipe.

I hereby certify that the foregoing statements made by me concerning the nature of the emergency, the date and time of its occurrence, and the need for emergency action are true.




EMERGENCY CONTRACT AWARDED
