REQUISITION FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF EMERGENCY WORK OR LABOR, OR THE FURNISHING OF EMERGENCY MATERIALS, SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

The following requisition is hereby being filed with you for the performance of emergency work or labor, or the furnishing of emergency materials, supplies and services.

The nature of the emergency is: A yard hydrant at the wastewater treatment plant was leaking. The nearest valve found to be most optimal to stop flow of utility water to the hydrant to make the necessary repair also stops flow to the sulfur dioxide feed equipment. A contractor was called to assist with shutting off the water to that hydrant and making the pipe repair. The water leak was fixed by 7pm on 12/20/2024 and the sulfur dioxide system was checked. Water backed up into the sulfur dioxide feed system appearing to not function as it should. The effluent discharge was tested with good results at the time.

The equipment would normally be switched to a backup system in this instance to be sure it would be fine but being that 1 of 2 sulfur dioxide feed systems are in working condition Authority management decided to monitor the plant overnight after the water repair. At 2am when Quentin Nixon arrived to monitor the treatment, it was found that sulfur dioxide was not feeding into the system and the plant was in violation of permit.

The date and time of the emergency: Friday, December 20, 2024 12:30pm, staff noticed leaking hydrant and were not able to shut off the water.

The need for the emergency work or labor or the furnishing of emergency materials, supplies or services is as follows: RTW Construction to supply necessary equipment and labor to excavate and repair broken water line. Parts/Pumps to repair the Sulfur Dioxide Feed System to alleviate feed issues.

I hereby certify that the foregoing statements made by me concerning the nature of the emergency, the date and time of its occurrence, and the need for emergency action are true.
