RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, FOR CONGRESSIONALLY DIRECTED SPENDING AND COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING FOR FY 2024.

WHEREAS, the Bordentown Sewerage Authority submitted to NJ legislators a request for funding to modernize the Black Creek Wastewater Treatment plant, principally the aerated grit chamber, plant drain pump station and the soda ash chemical feed system; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's project "Bordentown Sewerage Authority Blacks Creek Waste Water Treatment Plant Improvement Project" was chosen to receive federal funding in the amount of \$1,803,000.00; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of the receipt of the federal funding, there is a cost share requirement for the Authority to pay twenty percent of the project cost, calculated to be \$450,750.00; and

WHEREAS, the Bordentown Sewerage Authority commits to the funding of the cost share requirement with Unrestricted Net Position fund reserves.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 16th day of June 2025, The Bordentown Sewerage Authority hereby authorizes the submission of application to receive the federal funding for the improvements to the wastewater treatment plant, via Grants.gov.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bordentown Sewerage Authority consents to the understandings and assurances of the grant program, and to satisfying the institutional, managerial, and financial capabilities of the program in order to ensure proper planning, management and completion of the project, as described in the Grant application.
