REVENUES (page F-2) - The residential connection fees are anticipated to be lower than the previous year in the amount of \$475,233, and commercial connection fees are anticipated from the connection of two warehouses.

APPROPRIATIONS (page F-4)

Fringe benefit costs are anticipated to increase due to health insurance cost increase. Commercial insurance rates increased in 2024 and are anticipated to increase again in 2025.

The debt service interest payment is less than the prior year per the loan schedule.

At the present time there is one housing development which is anticipated to complete construction in early 2025.

There is a single family home with Planning Board approval that has not begun construction. There are two warehouses under construction which are anticipated to be completed mid 2025.

Unrestricted Net Position is not being utilized in the proposed operating Annual Budget.

The Bordentown Sewerage Authority utilizes connection fees collected in previous years to balance the budget when needed.

Fees collected in excess of budgetary expenditures represent the Unrestricted Net Position available in subsequent years for the Authority's budgetary needs.

The Authority pays \$4,000.00 per year for the current contract with City of Bordentown Water Utility. The water utility provides the Authority with water meter readings for usage fees to be charged on the Authority's customer billing. The Authority entered into the Intermunicipal Sludge Management Agreement with County of Burlington for sludge processing and co-composting services. The services are paid on a monthly basis to Treasurer, County of Burlington. The Authority pays for unleaded and diesel fuel on a monthly basis to Bordentown Regional School District.
