RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF PIPE INVENTORY FROM THE NORTH JERSEY WASTEWATER COOPERATIVE PURCHASING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2(b)(3), the Bordentown Sewerage Authority ("Authority") is authorized to join State and national purchasing cooperatives; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-69, the Authority is authorized to join the North Jersey Wastewater Cooperative Purchasing System, administered by the Passaic Valley Sewer Commission; and

WHEREAS, due to the age and condition of the Authority's Sewer collection system, on occasion, the sewer system experiences blockages and broken pipes, which require immediate repair; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Executive Director is requesting approval to purchase pipe and pipe connections in various sizes to facilitate future repairs; and

WHEREAS, Raritan Group Inc., ("Raritan") of New Brunswick, NJ, was awarded a contract by the North Jersey Wastewater Cooperative Purchasing System to furnish and deliver pipe, fittings, valves and accessories for a one year period under Contract No. B442-2; and

WHEREAS, Raritan proposes to furnish PVC Elbows, Compact Sleeves, Megalug Restraints and Flip Couplings in pipe sizes 4", 6", 8", 10", and 12", as detailed in its quote dated July 22, 2025, in the amount of \$11,945.78 through the purchasing cooperative; and

WHEREAS, a certificate of availability of funds has been provided by the designated certifying finance officer and is attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the Bordentown Sewerage Authority, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that authorization is hereby granted to award a contract, to Raritan Group, Inc., ("Raritan") of New Brunswick, NJ, pursuant to the North Jersey Wastewater Cooperative Purchasing System Contract No. B442-2, for PVC Elbows, Compact Sleeves, Megalug Restraints and Flip Couplings in multiple quantities, in pipe sizes 4", 6", 8", 10", and 12", as detailed in its quote dated July 22, 2025, in the amount of \$11,945.78.
