RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY ENDORSING MULTIPLE TREATMENT WORKS APPROVAL (TWA) PERMIT APPLICATIONS AND THE WELLINGTON WOODS PUMP STATION FLOOD HAZARD AREA (FHA) VERIFICATION APPLICATION. FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE AUTHORITY'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO SIGN ALL TWA PERMIT APPLICATION FORMS OF THE TREATMENT WORKS APPROVAL PERMIT APPLICATIONS IN THE APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE AUTHORITY'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO SIGN ALL RELATED FHA VERIFICATION APPLICATION FORMS IN THE APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS

WHEREAS, Bordentown Sewerage Authority ("Authority") is intending to make improvements to the following three locations owned by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the improvement projects are known as,

First Location: "Bywater Pump Station Modifications", identified on the official tax map of Bordentown Township as Block 17, Lot 1.02

Second Location: "Wellington Woods Pump Station Modifications", identified on the official tax map of Bordentown Township as Block 31, Lot 86

Third Location: "Blacks Creek WWTP Soda Ash Solution Dissolver Tanks Replacement" identified on the official tax map of Bordentown Township as Block 128.01, Lot 19 (collectively the "Properties"); and

WHEREAS, in order for the Authority to make the proposed improvements to the Properties, it must first obtain from the State of New Jersey, Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Water Quality certain approvals and permits; and

WHEREAS, the Authority will need to submit an endorsed Treatment Works Approval Permit Application for each of the Properties.

WHEREAS, the Authority will need to submit an endorsed Flood Hazard Area Verification Permit Application for the Wellington Woods Pump Station property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, THAT:

1. Both the Treatment Works Approval Permit Applications and Flood Hazard Area Permit Application shall be endorsed upon the recommendation of the Bordentown Sewerage Authority's consulting engineer for submittal to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.
2. The Authority hereby authorizes its Executive Director, Charles Bluhm, Jr. to sign the appropriate sections of the Treatment Works Approval application forms for all three project's after the Bordentown Sewerage Authority's consulting engineer provides the recommendation for signature for each.
3. The Authority hereby authorizes its Executive Director, Charles Bluhm, Jr. to sign the appropriate sections of the Wellington Woods Pump Station FHA Verification forms for this project's application after the Bordentown Sewerage Authority's consulting engineer provides the recommendation for signature.
