# REQUISITION FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF EMERGENCY WORK OR LABOR, OR THE FURNISHING OF EMERGENCY MATERIALS, SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

TO: Charles Bluhm, Executive Director

The following requisition is hereby being filed with you for the performance of emergency work or labor, or the furnishing of emergency materials, supplies and services.

The nature of the emergency is: While doing routine station check at Mile Hollow pump station on Friday, July 18th, 2025, BSA staff noticed a small amount of water flowing through a valve on the force main inside the station. It was reported to the supervisor, Quentin Nixon, at 11:15am. Further inspection determined it to be flow coming from the pump station force main through a faulty valve. Quentin Nixon contacted Charles Bluhm at 11:40am. Quentin Nixon called RTW at 11:50am. Charles Bluhm called licensed operators Richard Eustace at 11:57am and called David Kennedy at 11:58am. Charles Bluhm called Richard Czekanski, Consulting Engineer at 12:17pm. By approximately 1pm, RTW, David Kennedy, and Rick Czekanski were at the pump station site with BSA staff. An excavation test pit was dug, and it was determined that a replacement valve could not be located right away. A contractor's pump was placed inside the pit with a hose leading back to the wet well.

The date and time of the emergency: July 18, 2025 at 11:15am.

The need for the emergency work or labor or the furnishing of emergency materials, supplies or services is as follows: RTW Construction and Garrison to supply necessary equipment and labor to excavate and repair the broken valve, and Engineering input for the valve repair, and Licensed Operator hours on site. Pump rental was provided by Xylem and certain piping was purchased from Stevenson Supply.

I hereby certify that the foregoing statements made by me concerning the nature of the emergency, the date and time of its occurrence, and the need for emergency actions are true.
