**RESOLUTION OF THE BORDENTOWN SEWERAGE
AUTHORITY, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE
AUTHORITY'S PARTICIPATION IN A SERVICE
AGREEMENT WITH APTEGY FOR WEBSITE
HOSTING AND DESIGN UPGRADE**

WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act was updated to include guidelines for accessibility to be implemented by all State and local governments' web content by April 2027; and

WHEREAS, Apptegy has proposed to the Bordentown Sewerage Authority ("Authority") website design services that will allow the Authority to provide a website compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's solicitor has reviewed the master services agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Authority wishes through this resolution to memorialize its participation with Apptegy to redesign the Authority's website and provide support and hosting services in future years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED, by the Board Members of the Bordentown Sewerage Authority, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

1. The Authority hereby authorizes and agrees to enter into an agreement with Apptegy consistent with the Agreement attached hereto.


2. The Authority's Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute the Aptegey Master Services Agreement for website design services as well as annual fees for the Bordentown Sewerage Authority.
3. The Authority's Executive Director and Administrative Manager are hereby further authorized to undertake any and all necessary actions to ensure the redesigned website is fully implemented.
4. Any and all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.


