

## RESOLUTION 2026-023

WHEREAS, there exists a need for the services of an attorney-at-law to serve as Labor Counsel for The Bordentown Sewerage Authority; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose and a certificate of availability of funds has been provided by the designated certifying finance officer and is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of Contract for "professional services" without competitive bids and the resulting contract must be available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law further requires that a Notice of the award of the contract be printed as a legal advertisement; and

WHEREAS, this Contract was awarded after a fair and open process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by The Bordentown Sewerage Authority this 17th day of February, 2026 as follows:


1. Malamut & Associates, LLC, be and the same is hereby appointed as Labor Counsel for The Bordentown Sewerage Authority. The term of appointment is effective March 1, 2026 and shall be for a term of one year.

2. This Contract is awarded without competitive bidding after a fair and open process as a "professional service" in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a) of the Local Public Contracts Law because said contract encompasses a professional service recognized, and regulated by law.

3. The Chair and Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to execute the professional services contract with Malamut & Associates, LLC.

4. Notice of this action shall be published once as a legal advertisement in the official newspaper of The Bordentown Sewerage Authority within ten days of its adoption.





## Compensation Proposal

### **F. Compensation proposal.**

Malamut and Associates, LLC proposes to represent the Bordentown Sewerage Authority on an hourly fee basis. Although Mr. Crook's hourly rates for private sector engagements normally ranges from \$325.00 to \$375.00 per hour, Malamut and Associates proposes to bill Mr. Crook's services at a reduced rate of \$200.00 for services performed as Labor Counsel.

Other partners at the firm may assist in specialized areas of law, where necessary and appropriate. The maximum rate that the firm will charge for those attorneys' services will be \$200.00 per hour, notwithstanding those attorneys' billing rates normally range up to \$350.00 per hour, depending on the experience of the attorney and the complexity of the matter requiring their service.

Other associate attorneys at the firm may assist where necessary and appropriate. The maximum rate that the firm will charge for those attorneys' services will be \$165.00 per hour. Paralegal services will be charged at a rate of \$100.00 per hour. Out-of-pocket expenses will be charged at actual cost, without the application of any mark-up.
